

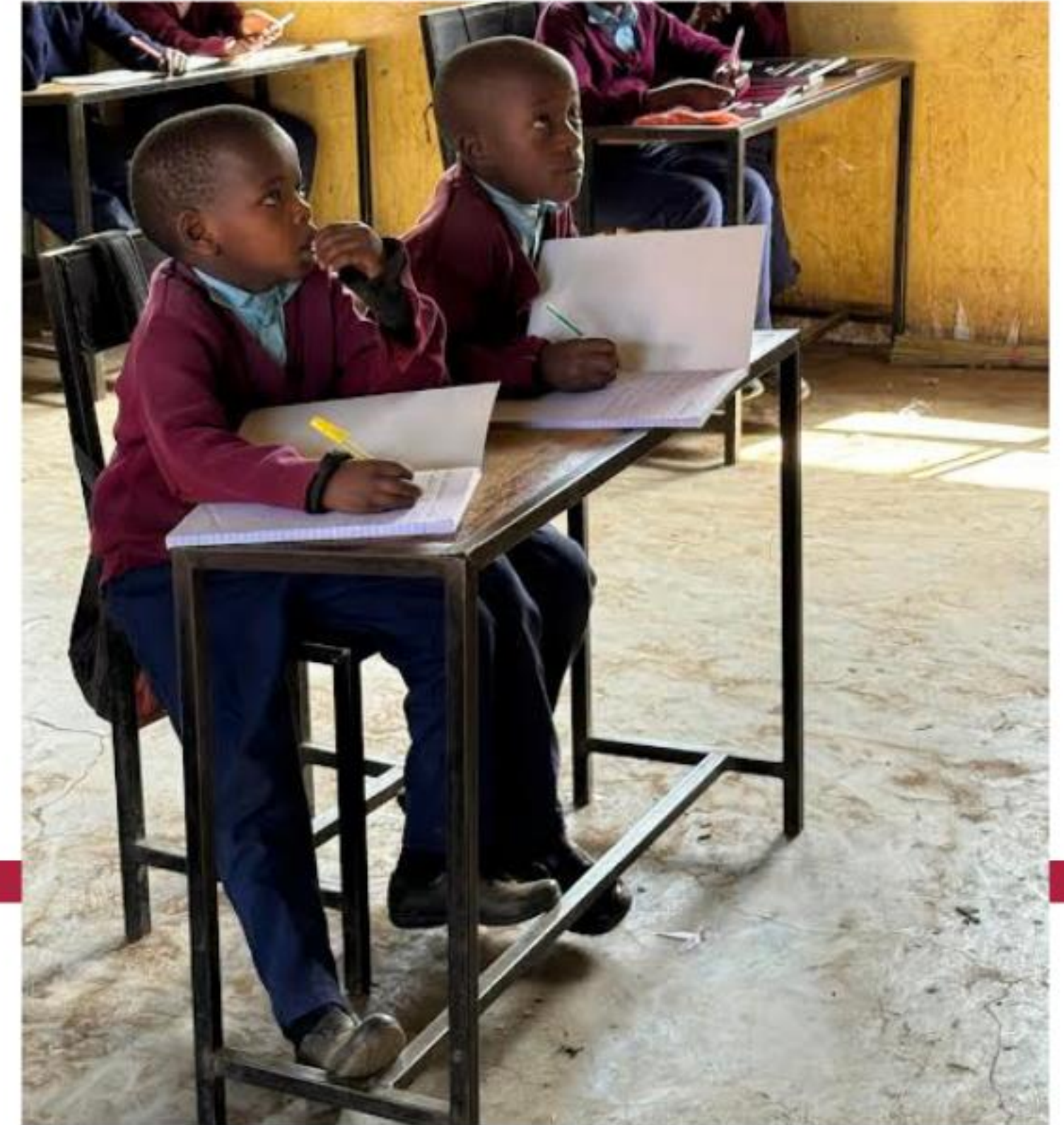

»»» Widow Ministry

Ormee completed many home visits to local widows, providing prayer, encouragement and meeting physical needs. Many of these widows have children attending Ormee school. With Ormee support, one woman, Neema, started a Sunday school program, serving over 70 vulnerable children in her village!

One of the biggest blessings for Ormee School in 2023 was the building of our first dorm. This dorm will house these precious girls and provide them with a safe place to live and learn and offers them further protection from dangers like FGM and early marriage.

»»» STANDARD 7 RESULTS

Our Standard 7 students took the annual exam to determine if they could move on to secondary school and ALL TEN passed! We rejoice with these young people. These are truly amazing and life changing results for these Maasai students and are made possible by supporters like you.



»»» LIBRARY

A library was built and dedicated at Ormee School! With donor support, we were able to purchase the first set of grade level curriculum for Ormee and resource materials like maps and dictionaries. This is an invaluable resource for our teachers and students and the first library in this bush area!

»»» COMMUNITY HEALTH PROJECTS

Ormee staff completed community health trainings in 2023, which serve as an *outreach to the unreached* in the surrounding villages and helps alleviate some of the many health challenges they face. Christmas food baskets were distributed and blessed nearly 200 families! Programs like these are very impactful, yet inexpensive. Let us know if you would like to sponsor!
